Packed Lunches

We promote a healthy lifestyle and encourage healthy choices when making packed lunches. Do not include foods such as chocolate or sweets. You do not need to include lunchtime drinks as we provide these. Please do not send in items containing nuts as we have children with allergies.

Please remember that if you are including items such as grapes, sausages and tomatoes, these do need to be chopped. Grapes should always be cut length ways and into quarters.

Invoices

Messy Play

Please do not send your child to pre-school

in their best clothes. We love to have fun making lots of mess with paint, glue, food, water play etc.



Medication

Please ensure any medication has the dispensing label from the Chemists on, clearly showing your child's name. Please also bring in any relevant information from the doctors.

NEVER leave medication in your child's bag as the children do have access to their bags.

If your child needs nappy cream, please bring one in to leave here, again labelled by the Chemists, showing your child's name.

Coughs, Colds and Viruses

Please do not bring your child to the preschool if they are generally unwell, have a temperature, sickness or diarrhoea.

If they have a temperature, please keep them off. Please do not give them Calpol to lower a temperature and then bring them in as they become poorly again when the next dose of Calpol would be due.

If they are prescribed antibiotics, please keep them at home for 48 hours from when they start taking them.

Bags and Clothes

Please ensure your child brings a named bag to Pre-School each day with a spare set of named clothes and pants as they often enjoy water play. Also include a spare pair of socks as they tend to get wet if they have a toilet accident.

If your child wears nappies, please make sure they have both nappies and wipes in their bag. Please make sure they have enough to last the day.

Please ensure all items are named, including packed lunch boxes and wipes.
